A special elder guest, Julia Parker, a Kashia Pomo Indian of Stewarts Point Rancheria in California, will have a demonstration at this years camp.

Julia will demonstrate the entire process of preparing and cook-

ing acorns. She is one of a few that still uses a basket and rocks to cook the acorns.

The Cow Creek Tribe received a 2005 Traditional Arts Apprenticeship Grant from the Oregon Historical Society. The grant has made it possible for Julia to bring her demonstration to us.

The Cow Creek Tribe has more than six education programs available for Cow Creek tribal members. The programs include: Adult Education, Adult Voca-

tional Training, Higher Education, Employment Enhancement, Life-Time Learning, Continuing Education and the Distance Education Program.

The education programs have individual guidelines that determine eligibility.

## Tribal Education Programs

Adult Education is available for Cow Creek tribal members who live within the 7-county service area. The Adult Education assistance is intended for employment enhancement classes, GED preparation classes and GED testing fees.

Tribal Employment Enhancement is available for Cow Creek tribal members that live outside the 7-county service area. The Tribal Employment Enhancement assistance is intended for employment enhancement classes, GED preparation classes and GED testing fees.

Adult Vocational Training is available for Cow Creek tribal members who live within the 7-county service area. The Adult Vocational Training assistance is intended for vocational training programs that will be complete within 2 years.

Higher Education Program is available for Cow Creek tribal members regardless of where they live. The Higher Education Program assistance is intended for obtaining a 4 year degree from a college or university, or for pursuing a Master's degree program or Doctoral degree program.

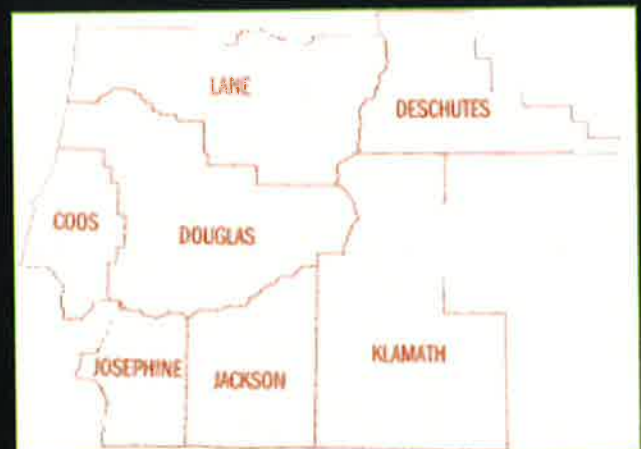
Continuing and Distance Education Program is available for Cow Creek tribal members regardless of where they live. The Continuing and Distance Education Program is intended for the completion of a certificate program, 2 year de-

gree, 4 year degree, Master's degree or Doctoral degree. Tribal members are required to take 1-7 credits each quarter/semester and be working toward one of the defined degree programs.

Life Time Learning Program is available for Cow Creek tribal members regardless of where they live. The Life Time Learning Program encompasses classes approved by the Tribal Board of Directors.

## Huckleberry Management Open House

The Umpqua and Rogue National Forests will be holding two public open houses in May, to introduce a plan to designate a 9,461 acre area bordering the Umpqua and Rogue National Forests as a Special Interest Area (SIA) in order to provide options for future management of huckleberries.

from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the Umpqua National Forest Supervisors Office, located at 2900 NW Stewart Parkway, Roseburg, OR 97470.

The second open house will be held on Tuesday, May 10, 2005 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the Jackson County Library, located at 205 South Central Avenue, Medford, OR 97501.
