Cow Creek's World Wide Web

Our World Wide Web site became operational in May and continues to grow and improve. Content is constantly being prepared and added. New internal links and information are being developed. Links to other related sites are being added as they are identified, especially other Native American home pages. Our address on the Internet is www.cowcreek.nsn.us. The nsn stands for Native Sovereign Nation, and with the "us" ending the site is permanently reserved for us for free. We also reserved "cowcreek.com" to block the possibility of anyone else using our name for commercial ("com") purposes.

There are areas of our home page that are password protected. This ensures that that information is restricted to Tribal members only. When you access these areas you will be asked to provide a password (it is "My-n-e-letta"; the english transcription of our ancestor's name as it

appears on the 1853 treaty). Here is the procedure to follow:

When the protected section first opens on the screen, you will have two options. The first option is to sign in to get a user name. The computer will ask you for your name, city and state. Fill in those three blanks. The computer will then assign you a user name. Make a record of your user name. Write it down for future use. Next the computer will ask you for your user name and password. Type in your user name exactly as it was spelled. Then type in the password exactly as it was spelled. You must contact the tribal office to get the password. Keep it confidential. Capital letters must appear as capital letters.

The second option on the access screen for the password area is used when you already have a user name. Just type in your user name and the password to get into the protected area.

Take a look at the links to other Native American home pages, especially Oregon Tribes in the Oregon Tribes section. The home page also links to the Seven Feathers home page. Select the Economic Development button on our home page opening screen. Then select the Seven Feathers Hotel & Casino Resort button. Comments on our home page are always welcome and can be sent through the Webmaster or Tribal Contact buttons on the home page opening screen.

Important Information Needed

Social Security Number's must be reported in order to receive gaming distributions

Federal law requires that all gaming revenue per capita distributions to tribal members must be properly reported to the IRS by the Tribe. Failure to properly report gaming revenue per capita distributions to tribal members could result in fines and liability to the Tribe and non-reporting tribal members. In order to properly report the distributions to the IRS, the Tribe must have your social security number.

In order to receive future distribution checks you must provide your social security number to the Tribe. *Tribal members who have not yet provided their social security number to the Tribe for purposes of IRS gaming revenue per capita reporting will not receive distribution checks until they have provided the required information.* Any fines levied upon the Tribe, due to non-reporting tribal members, may be withheld from such members' future distribution.
