The May meeting will be MAY 21, 1989. The Executive Council meeting will start at 9:00 a.m. and the General Council meeting will be at 1:00 p.m. Both of these meetings will be held in the Canyonville Youth Center. There are important issues that will be reviewed. We encourage everyone to attend.

## FROM THE TRIBAL OFFICE

<u>ADULT VOCATIONAL TRAINING:</u> The AVT Committee approved three (3) tribal members to be funded in the AVT Program. The areas of training chosen by these individuals are landscaping/greenhouse, computer software, and professional truck driving. If you are interested in these or any other areas of training, please contact the Tribal Office and request an application/

ADULT EDUCATION: Currently there is one tribal member enrolled in preparatory classes to obtain their GED. If you would like more information on this program, please feel free to call the office. Ideas for a community education class are being collected. If you have any input, please call and tell us your interest. Several classes being considered are basketry, beading, leather crafts, and Indian Art. Recently acquired under the Adult Education Program are various cassette tapes that will be of interest to tribal members. Among these tapes, topics include, "Word Builders" Volume 1-3 (60 minutes program for building a more powerful vocabulary), "Siblings without Rivalry" (How to help your children live together so you can live too), "The Complete Guide to Home Loans" (Everything you need to know about financing your first home or re-financing existing loans), "Stop Smoking through Self Hypnosis" (Change your life with powerful information and relaxing guided hypnosis), "Self Hypnosis and Subliminal Reinforcement" (Building self confidence), The Dance of Anger" (Women's guide that shows women how to turn anger into a constructive force for re-shaping their life), and "Add up to 300 Points to Your Fat Score" (Self help study guide for the F.A.T.

These tapes may be checked out through the office by the week. Depending on the response, we hope to acquire more of these self help tapes.

SOCIAL SERVICE: There is a Headstart Program in Canyonville and Myrtle Creek. This program is a definite pre-school program that teaches the basics such as; numbers, shapes, colors, etc. This program works on the child self esteem and social graces. Headstart provides a snack in the morning and lunch. They will also provide dental and medical exams. There is also a home based program available. This program accepts children three and four years of age. Four year olds are placed on a priority list if their birthday is before September 1. This program is for low income families and there is no cost but you must meet the income guidelines, which is Federal poverty level.
