
Dear Tribal Member:

Once again, the dissident faction has sent out notices; this time announcing that nominations will be October 15, 1989, and elections will be Nov. 12, 1989.

The Bureau of Indian Affairs recognizes the 1988 Board of Directors as the governing body of the Tribe.

Corrine Hill has absolutely no authority to call a meeting for nominations.

A special general council meeting was convened on Oct. 8, 1989, at the dissident factions request. When nominations were not held, the dissident faction adjourned the general council meeting.
