Census Information

U. S. Census forms are to be filled out and returned to Census takers beginning April 1. If you are a tribal member married to a non-tribal member, you must put your name first on the census form. If you do not put your name first, your family will not be counted as Native American. It is important that families register as Native American because these figures affect Federal dollars for Indian programs.

Higher Education

The deadline for submission of applications for the Higher Education Program for Fall term 1990 will be April 1, 1990. It is important to remember that this program has no service area requirements, therefore tribal members residing outside of the tribal service area are eligible to submit applications. Adult Education

The Adult Education Program will be sponsoring a Beginning Guitar Class through Southbound Sound in Roseburg, as part of a series of community education classes. The guitar class will be a series of 6 weekly 45 minute sessions beginning April 5, 1990 - May 10, 1990, 6:00 pm - 6:45 pm. The lessons will be paid for by the Adult Education Program, however, if you do not own a guitar, these will be available to rent for the six week session at a rate of \$18. The guitars should be rented prior to the first class by calling or visiting Southbound Sound, 443 N.E. Stephens Street, Roseburg, Oregon, 672-7056. If you are interested in this class, please contact the Tribal Office by April 2, 1990 to sign up.

Adult Vocational Training Program

Any Tribal members interested in applying for the Adult Vocational Training Program should contact the tribal office to obtain an application packet. It is important to apply for Financial Aid through the College. A Financial Aid Form will be included in your application packet and it is

Housing Improvement Program

The Housing Improvement Program has recently completed one category B (rehabilitation of an existing home) and one category C (assistance in obtaining a down payment for a standard unit). Two catagory D's (complete new construction) and one more catagory C (..down payment) are planned for this year.

A Family centered workshop will be offered in the near future. The workshop will focus on parent-child relationships. Issues of communication, trust, self-esteem and The Family "as a system" will be presented. More information will be provided in the upcoming newsletter.
