ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Energy assistance is available through many counties in the state of Oregon. Some of the counties have already started scheduling appointments for this program.

The Energy Assistance Program "one-time payment" opportunity for low income families. This program can assist in paying for electric, gas, oil, propane and wood heat. Ιt has specific guidelines for each household that is applying assistance, such as proof of gross income, social security cards & birthdates for each member of the household over the age of 2 years and a current electric bill. needed would be the most current bill from any other heat source excluding wood.

If you think you exceed the income guidelines, you may be able to reduce your household income to meet the criteria for the program by providing proof of paid medical bills and prescriptions which were not reimbursed to you for the past 12 months. Also, proof of medical insurance and child care receipts would be helpful.
